SIBU: A fire broke out at a factory in Samalaju Industrial Park in Bintulu this afternoon.

According to information from the Fire and Rescue Department (Bomba) operation center, a team of firemen were deployed to the scene immediately upon receiving a distress call at 3.32pm.

Upon arriving at the scene, firemen sighted smoke billowing from the building and began preparing to extinguish the blaze.

Firemen were assisted by the factory's emergency response team (ERT) consisting of 48 staff members using, 15 nozzles to douse the fire.

According to the information obtained the safety officer, hydrogen materials mixed with silicone caused the spread of the fire.

No casualties or injuries were reported.

The operation ended at 4.25pm.
